Qualifications Requirement:

Performing skilled work in the maintenance and repair of generating units and other mechanical equipment in the power plant under the Trade Specialist or the Distribution Supervisor. Able to assist all services needed in the Power Plant during the irregularities operation.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- On daily basis, Mechanic checks and tops-up lubricating oil in Turbo Chargers, Governors, Pedestal Bearings and Air Compressors.
- On daily basis, flush Turbo Chargers Engines (one in services).
- Carry out repair work as required and performs duties as advised by his supervisor
- On weekly basis, clean centrifugal filters on Engines in services.
- Carry out routine maintenance work on Engine
- Assist in overhaul of generators
- Carry out general clean-up work of the Power Plant
- Checking and cleaning of tools
- Assist in the maintenance and repair power plant related equipment.
- Troubleshooting the problem on engine
- Record materials use, oil, fuel and future requirement.
- Dismantle and overhaul the engine
- Know about parts, tolls and order parts as needed.
- Perform other related duties as assigned
- Maintains a clean and safe working area and good serviceable equipment and tools.
- Check all generators in operation for necessary oil change, filters and other schedule parts repair and services.
- Inspects equipments to determine needed repairs.
- Keeps the Trade Specialist/ Distribution Supervisor informed at all times of any problem that arise
- Repairs and carries out PM services for all KUA vehicles and equipments.
- Maintained watch until relieved
- Perform other duties as assigned

Qualification Requirement:

- Should be a high school graduate
- Knowledge of standard principles, methods, practice, techniques, tools, and test equipment used in the maintenance and repair of plant equipments.
- Four years experience in the maintenance and repair of mechanical machinery and equipment in the power plant.

Qualifications Requirement:

Performs all classes of line work, of any voltage, in construction, installation, maintenance, and operations of overhead transmission and distribution lines, substations equipment. Performs all classes of underground work in the installation, maintenance, and operations of non-leaded cable installations.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Installs, splices, terminates, maintains and replaces non-leaded cables. Installs pad mount transformers.
- Install, replaces and / or removes all classes of line work, of any voltage, in the construction, installation, maintenance and operations of overhead transmission and distribution lines, substations and substation equipment.
- Inspects, tests, services and repairs liens and equipment, and maybe required to report on conditions of same.
- May be required to drive a truck and operate associated equipment as assigned.
- Works on energized lines and equipment using protective equipment as required.
- Applies Company's constructions safety standards and other applicable rules and procedures.
- May install and remove residential single phase meters. Directs the work of personnel in lower classifications on any or all of the above operations.
- Install and maintains street light circuits
- Climb utility poles to install and repair overhead transmission line, cross arms, transformers and regulators.
- Set poles and strings cable from pole to pole or to a building.
- Splices and solders cables for connection.
- Uses nails, screws or bolts for installation of electrical equipment.
- Trim trees when necessary to provide clearance for lines.
- Read and interprets and works from blueprints, sketches and specifications.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
- Provide guidance to maintenance and repair personnel: diagnoses causes of electrical failure or operational difficulties. Spot checks problem areas and takes corrective actions.
- Ensure good PR with the customers and working relationship among distribution crews are maintained.

- Must be able to read and understand English
- Must have basic knowledge in using computer
- Must have a customer friendly personality
